Street Fix in the Works

Many of you have been wondering what's happening with the repairs to Brimmer Way from the heavy rains we experienced in August. The Village of Cherry Valley Public Works Department is not yet responsible for our streets, at least as far as repairs go. Until such time as the final layer of asphalt is applied to Brimmer Way and Fairway View, the responsibility for repairing the street belongs to the subdivision developer, Bob Streeter.

Mr. Streeter is currently collecting bids to both repair the damaged portion of the street and to install the final layer of asphalt on the sections where it is needed. It is his intent, from what we have been told, that the work will be done this Fall. A firm date should be set once the bids for the work come in. Once the street is repaired and the second layer of asphalt is installed, responsibility for the streets will be turned over to Cherry Valley.

Flu Season Here, Get Your Shots

October is traditionally the start of the flu season, and this year is expected to be no different from past years.

The Boone County Health Department has already scheduled a number of flu clinics for those interested in getting flu shots. Cost this year is \$30.00. The dates below are for adults and for children age 4 and older.

Here are the currently scheduled dates and locations in Belvidere:

4:00 - 6:30 PM at Health Dept Office, 1204 Logan Ave

Sprinkler Systems Must Be Inspected

Now that Fall is here, many of our residents are at least thinking about having their sprinkler systems blown out and closed down for the season. This is a good time to remind you about Cherry Valley's regulations on Backflow Prevention Device Inspection and Maintenance.

The Village of Cherry Valley's Department of Public Works states that the Illinois EPA requires any home served by Cherry Valley water that has an automatic irrigation system must have a working backflow prevention device. These Reduced Pressure and Double Check Valve backflow assemblies are to be tested at the time of installation and tested again at least annually by a person who is certified as competent to service the device. Generally, the company you hire to winterize your sprinkler system should be able to do this.

If any repairs are necessary to the backflow device, they must be made *immediately* and are at the expense of the homeowner. These devices cannot be bypassed, removed, or otherwise made inoperable without specific authorization by the Cherry Valley Director of Public Works.

The Village must receive a signed copy of the inspection report on the backflow device for their records. For further information about this backflow device inspection regulation, please contact Joe Caveny at the Cherry Valley Department of Public Works. His phone number is 815-332-3441.

Traffic Safety Reminder – SLOW DOWN!
